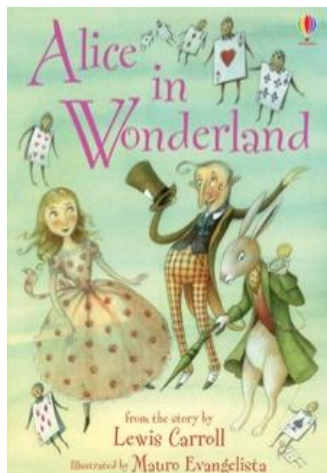


## English

In English this term we will be looking at the story Alice in Wonderland by Lewis Carroll. The children will be learning to write character and setting descriptions, and diary entries.

We will be learning about sentence structures, punctuation, text structures, and developing our understanding of grammar terminology,

In phonics, the children will be building on their knowledge of sounds and using this to develop their knowledge of spelling patterns.
