Art

To end the topic we will look at future transport and find out about space travel by exploring the Apollo 11 mission to the moon.

Maths

We are looking at place value and will learn about the value of digits in 2 digit numbers.

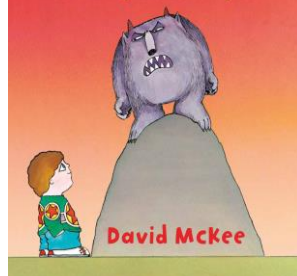
We will be reading *The Tiger Who Came to Tea*, *Not now Bernard* and non-fiction books on travel this half-term.

English: We are looking at stories with familiar settings. We are using the title and front cover to think what the story might be about. We are using the illustrations and using inference and deduction to predict what might happen next in the story and why. We are using role play and drama to help with character descriptions and discussions.

Maths: We are looking at place value and will be focussing on the number system up to 10. The children will develop a deep understanding of numbers, sequences, patterns and value. To be fluent in saying 1 more and 1 less from a given number, to be able to reason and solve problems and to explain their thinking e.g. how would you sort this group of objects and why?
