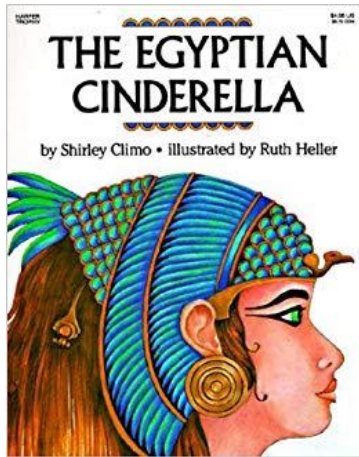


English

Already we have started to look at the daily life of the Ancient Egyptians and their beliefs. On our Topic Launch day we looked at the discovery of King Tutankhamun by Howard Carter.

Over the coming weeks, we will be looking into the pyramids, The Nile and other areas of Egyptian life, exploring the answers to questions generated by the children.
