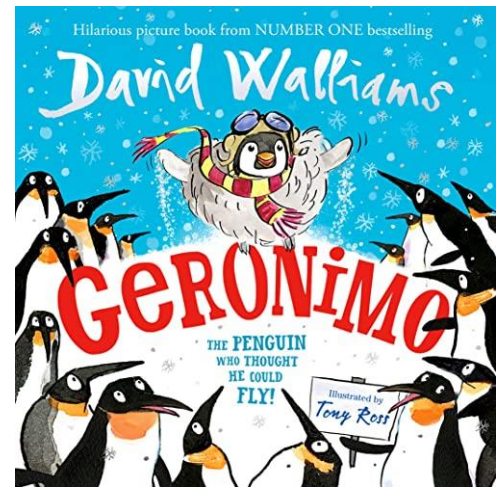
Literacy and understanding of the world.

We are using the book 'Geronimo' by David Walliams to support our learning this term. We will be exploring polar habitats and learning about the lifecycles of the animals that live within them. We shall also explore the signs of winter and observe the changing states of ice.

We will sequence the story and retell in our own words. We shall begin writing short captions to describe what is happening in the picture, and will enjoy writing up our science experiments.

Mathematics

We are further consolidating our understanding of number by using the mastery approach. We shall compare various amounts, using practical resources to help us and continue to use a ten frame to support early addition. We will explore weights and measure using language such as heavier,



heaviest, balance, to make comparisons.
