


Our new RE topic is 'Myself '. We are considering 'How do we show we care for others?' and 'Why does it matter?' How can our actions 'Transform' the lives of others?

Key learning in English:

- To recognise the features of a letter.
- To be able to create and perform our own poetry.

In maths, we are looking at Place Value within 20. We will apply previous knowledge we have gained such as number bonds, recognising where numbers are on the number line and how place value can help us to order numbers. We will then move onto being able to add and subtract within 20, This will then be applied to solve a range of topic-related problems.

Key learning in maths:

- To represent numbers within 20.
- To use reasoning about numbers and relationships to solve more complex problems and explain thinking.
