Rivers, trade and Economics

This half term, Year 4 will be continuing their learning about water on our planet. We will be deep-diving into the waterways in Britain, as well as around the world. Not only will we be exploring the intricate details of rivers, but we will also be looking at how human beings have utilised water ways over history.



Electricity and Sound

In the last half term of the year, our topic focus will be electricity and sound. Year 4 will have opportunities to be hands on with real physics, as well as theoretical in their experimentation.
