AUTUMN TOPIC

This half term our topic is 'Me and my World'.







Our story (fiction) book to support our topic is 'Rainbow Fish' written by the author Marcus Pfister













Our information (non-fiction) books will focus on families, houses & homes, parts of the body, feelings and our senses (touch / taste / smell / hearing / seeing).

We will look at different types of houses and homes and talk about 'who lives in my house?'

Personal, social and emotional development

We will be learning to share and take turns with our new friends. We will work in small groups to play games and complete fun activities together. We will help each other to learn our new Nursery rules and routines. Our 'Rainbow Fish' story will support us to learn about being kind, sharing with others and exploring our feelings.

Communication and language development

Children are learning to develop and extend their language by building on the words they already know. We are helping the children to communicate with each other by encouraging them to 'use their words', through our daily group time activities.

Physical development

Children will take part in daily activities that use their hands to strengthen their muscles for early writing. These will include threading, drawing, transferring objects using tweezers and pegs, painting and turning and twisting construction materials.

Children will also have opportunities to run, climb and clamber in a safe environment both indoors and outdoors to develop their large physical skills and understanding of a healthy lifestyle.

Phonics Development

The Nursery children all take part in daily phonics time activities where we learn about recognising 'rhyme in words - "words that sound the same", rhythm in words and the blending and segmenting of words'.

Listening Bear will be helping us with our daily phonics time activities and he will also be helping us to recognise and name familiar resources and activities within the unit. In addition to this Listening Bear also helps us to learn and remember our Nursery rules and routines, and he especially likes to sing familiar Nursery Rhymes and songs with us at group times - he is a very busy Listening Bear and he makes sure we are too! \odot

Maths development

The Nursery children take part in daily maths time activities during our small group time sessions. During these sessions Quiz the Owl helps us to get better at counting, recognising and writing our numbers, she helps us to recognise and name our shapes, and she teaches us a new number song each week.

Our shapes this half term are the 2d 'circle' and the 3d 'sphere'. Can you and your child find and name any shapes at home? Can your child recognise and name the door number that they live at? Maybe you could go on a number and shape hunt whilst you are out and about. We love to hear about any learning that you do with your child outside of Nursery so please let us know if there is any learning opportunity from home that we can celebrate in Nursery.

IMPORTANT MESSAGES
