It is our intention to keep all parents fully informed during all phases of the planning for the proposed re-opening of school site.

As you are already aware, following last week's Government announcements it's suggested that schools may initially re-open to early years, year 1 and year 6 classes, and this is scheduled at the earliest from 1st June 2020. Our team is currently liaising with these year group parents to gauge the numbers for expected pupils to return to site. Of all of this though upmost is our pupils', their families and our staff teams' health, safety and well-being throughout the whole of this process.

Please let me know if you have any anxieties or fears regarding any proposed arrangements. As a team, we will support you as much as possible.

There is a detailed plan being put into place about how to support safe distancing within school, look after our pupils and providing quality education. In addition to this, risk assessments are being drawn up in order to keep every member of our team, including pupils and families 100% safe throughout this transition time.

During school closure, our online learning provision continues to promote a wonderful addition to teaching and learning. It is our aim to continue with this home learning service throughout any partial re-opening too. Rest assured, if your child is not in one of the first classes expected to return (Early Years, Y1 and Y6), they will still continue to be fully supported by their dedicated teachers and staff members.

I wish to take this opportunity to pay tribute to all members of our fantastic team – admin, site, catering and the teaching team. They really are going the extra mile to provide a wonderful support network for pupils and their families.
