In English, we will be looking at diary entries in line with our class book 'The Day the Crayons Quit'.

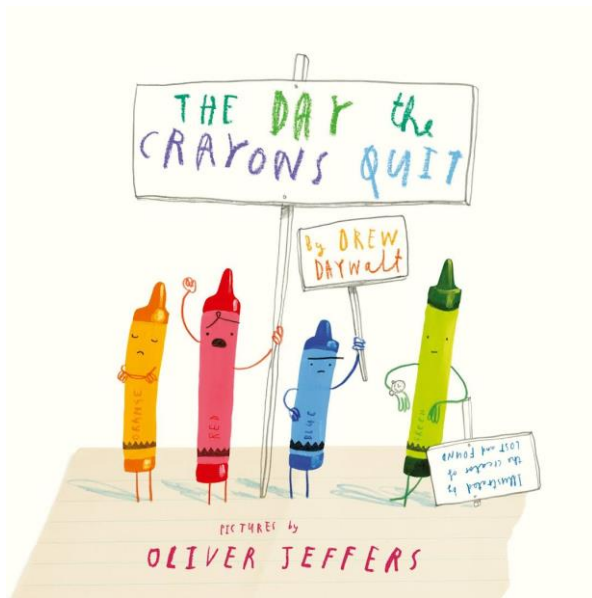
Maths

On Fridays, the children will focus on the key maths skills of addition, subtraction, multiplication and division, with an emphasis on problem-solving and reasoning skills. By the end of Year 3, your child will need to know the 2, 3, 4, 5,

8 and 10 times tables confidently. It is crucial that they are able to recall these times tables, so please support them with practising at home. Please note all pupils have access to Time Tables Rock Stars to help support their times tables recall skills. Please ensure your child logs on and practises at home.
